

Project Guide

Criss-Cross Border - Decorative dish

Glass Cutting: Simple straight lines

Firing: Contour fuse



Use this charming border technique to frame any design — from simple nipped flowers to anything you dream up!




Cut four $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" strips from Clear, two 6½" x 8" from Clear, and four $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 8" from Green.



Arrange layers as shown in diagram below. (Layer 2 is identical to layer 1, but rotated 90°.) Stack layers on kiln shelf lined with kiln shelf paper.





Nip or cut flowers (or any other design of your choice) and arrange in center. Contour fuse. Slump as desired.



Materials We Used

Glass Colors: 100SFS Clear, 123SF Medium Green, 151SF Cherry Red. Note: 171SF Orange was used for the flower variation shown in step 3.


